How to know when your loved one needs help?

(Check all boxes that apply)

- Is this someone with a disability?
- Does this individual need assistance walking?
- Are family members far away?
- Are you concerned for their safety?
- Do they forget easily?
- Do they have special dietary needs?
- Do they need help with daily tasks? (Bathing, Dressing, Cooking)
- Do they have frequent injuries?
- Has their personal hygiene habits changed?
- Are they having difficulty with daily chores? (Housekeeping, Shopping)
- Are they having trouble sleeping?
- Are they forgetful?
- Do they require transportation?

7. Do you run criminal background checks?
8. What means of communication do you use to update me on my loved one?
9. Do you have a minimum number of hours for service?
10. Do you require a contract to be signed?
11. Do you penalize if contract is broken?
12. Do you provide free assessments?
13. Do you do interim assessments? How often?
14. How quickly can you begin service?
15. What if the caregiver we have isn't working out?
16. Are you HIPAA compliant?
17. Will you provide me with a Privacy Policy and Client Rights?
